Dental Health Aide Therapists

New Edits for Claim Submission Effective May 1, 2012

In accordance with the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act and National Correct Coding Initiative, all individuals employed as Dental Health Aide Therapists (DHATs) are required to enroll as rendering providers to bill for services reimbursable by Medicaid.

Effective May 1, 2012, Alaska Medicaid will require that all claims submitted for dates of service beginning May 1, 2012 include the DHAT National Provider Identifier (NPI) for services rendered by a DHAT in Field 54 on the ADA Claim Form. The rendering DHAT provider NPI must be directly affiliated with the billing dental group. The supervising dentist must also be affiliated with this billing group. The DHAT NPI in Field 54 must match the NPI submitted to Provider Enrollment (remember to enroll via the Provider Enrollment Portal [PEP]).

In the example above, NPI 1234567890 belongs to DHAT Susan Smith. Taxonomy code 126800000X describes Susan's specialty. This was reported along with the NPI in Susan's PEP enrollment application.

Submission of a claim without complying with the above requirements will result in **delay or denial of payment** with an Edit 199, 211, 212, 213, 514 or 615 as described on the following page.



Edit	Description	Claim Pend/Deny Reason	Resolution
199	Rendering provider is inactive or not eligible on DOS	The DHAT indicated on the claim is not eligible to bill Alaska Medicaid for the claim DOS.	Contact Xerox provider enrollment @ 907-644-6800 option 2.
211	Rendering Provider Number Missing	Claim does not include the provider number of the DHAT who rendered the service.	Indicate the rendering DHAT NPI on the claim and resubmit.
212	Rendering Provider Not on File	The rendering DHAT indicated on the claim is not currently enrolled.	Verify the NPI submitted is accurate. If so, submit DHAT enrollment applications at https://enroll.medicaidalaska.com/ .
213	Rendering Provider is not a Member of the Billing Provider Group	The provider enrollment file does not indicate the rendering DHAT as a member of the billing provider's group.	If the DHAT is enrolled, submit the <i>Change of Provider Information Form</i> indicating the group affiliation, available at http://medicaidalaska.com (select <i>Providers > Forms</i>).
514	Billing group must include supervising provider	The billing group does not have a dentist enrolled with Alaska Medicaid for the claim DOS. Dentists are required to supervise DHAT services.	Enroll the Dentist DHAT supervisor in the billing group.
615	Licensing Not Valid on Date of Service	The provider enrollment file does not have a valid certification on the date of service listed on the claim.	Verify the date of service listed on the claim is accurate. If so, submit an updated DHAT certification to Provider Enrollment.
