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## CMS-1500 Claim Form Versions 08/05 and 02/12 Accepted During Transition

The National Uniform Claim Committee (NUCC) recently updated the CMS-1500 paper claim form. While Alaska Medicaid makes changes to fully support the new form, both the revised 02/12 version and the former 08/05 version will be accepted. ## Regulation Changes: Outpatient and Provider- Administered Drugs and Pharmacy Claims

New Pharmacy and Coverage regulations, effective May 18, 2014, will result in changes to pricing for outpatient prescription drugs, provider administered drugs, recipient copayments, pharmacy claims pricing, and covered drugs. The Service Authorization Request form has been updated. The revised form removes fields that are no longer used, includes a date of service field for retroactive authorizations, and contains more service lines. The Dental Service Authorization (SA) Request form is now available. This form has been designed to simplify the process of submitting dental SA requests by removing unnecessary fields and adding dental specific fields. ## New Speech-Language Evaluation Codes

Effective 01/01/2014, CPT 92506, speech evaluation, was replaced with four more specific CPT codes:

92521 Evaluation of speech fluency

92522 Evaluate speech production

92523 Eval speech sound lang comprehend

92524 Behavioral quality analys voice

Please begin using the new codes immediately for dates of service on and after January 1, 2014. Continue to use CPT 92506 when billing for dates of service prior to January 1, 2014.

## Changes to Qualis Service Authorization Doctor to Doctor Conversations

Qualis Health offers the opportunity for a doctor to doctor conversation when an adverse determination is made concerning a service authorization. The doctor to doctor conversation affords the requesting provider the opportunity to share additional information that may change the review determination.

Effective June 1, 2014 the opportunity for a doctor to doctor conversation will be offered in writing at the same time the provider is notified of the review determination. Under the current process, the offer is extended by telephone prior to issuance of the written determination.

## Tobacco Cessation Therapy and Behavior Management Policy Clarification

The Alaska Department of Health and Social Services has issued policy statements regarding tobacco cessation therapy and behavior management as provided by dentists.

Alaska Medicaid covers tobacco cessation services for recipients who use tobacco and want to quit, as well as medically necessary behavior management for recipients under age 21.

## Vaccine Coverage Changes

In accordance with 7 AAC 110.405(d)(15), Alaska Medicaid provides reimbursement for vaccine products for recipients under age 19 unless the vaccine is available for free to the provider through the Division of Public Health's Alaska Immunization Program.

Effective April 1, 2014, Alaska Medicaid will no longer cover the following vaccines available for free to providers through the Alaska Immunization Program: Influenza, Rotavirus, Hepatitis B, and Haemophilus Influenzae Type

B. The affected codes are 90655, 90657, 90680, 90681, and 90748.

This change does not affect the reimbursement for the administration of the vaccine.

## HPV Vaccine Coverage Change

The HPV vaccine product is now available for free to providers through the Division of Public Health for all Medicaid-eligible children under the age of 19. Effective July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2014, Alaska Medicaid will no longer reimburse for this product when administered to a recipient under the age of 19. This change does not affect the reimbursement for the administration of the vaccine; providers may still be reimbursed for the administration of the HPV vaccine.

## Use of VacTrAK Is Now Required

The Division of Public Health adopted reporting regulations that became effective December 29<sup>th</sup>, 2013. Reporting of vaccine administration data to VacTrAK, the Alaska Immunization Information System, is now required for all health care providers offering immunization services.
