## Rochester Optical: Alaska Medicaid's Sole Source Optical Services Contractor

Alaska Medicaid has received several inquiries regarding our current optical services contractor. We would like to confirm that Rochester Optical is the Alaska Medicaid Optical Services sole source contractor for lenses and eyeglass frames. All vision service providers are required to order from Rochester Optical when prescribing eyewear for Alaska Medicaid members. ## Payment Error Rate Measurement (PERM) Provider Education Sessions

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) will host quarterly PERM provider education sessions that will include presentations detailing:

- The PERM process
- Provider responsibilities during a PERM review
- Recent trends, frequent mistakes, and best practices

CMS will host provider education webinars on six occasions. It is necessary to attend only one session.

## Third Party Liability (TPL) Avoidance for Exhausted Benefits

Providers submitting claims through the electronic data interchange (EDI) may now indicate when a member's third party benefits have been exhausted for the service(s) being billed. Using this process allows the claim to bypass a manual claims processor review when there are no third party payments due to exhausted benefits. ## Dental Anesthesia Medicaid Policy Clarification

Alaska Medicaid covers dental-related anesthesia and IV sedation only if medically necessary and when provided in conjunction with a covered dental service. For example, anesthesia may be covered in conjunction with third molar removal if 7 AAC 110.145 and 7 AAC 110.155 (<http://www.akleg.gov/basis/aac.asp>) have been satisfied. However, because Alaska Medicaid does not cover dental implants, anesthesia associated with the provision of implants is not covered, even if 7 AAC 110.145 and 7 AAC 110.155 are satisfied.

## Office Consultations via Telemedicine Applications

Medically necessary office consultations (CPT 99241, 99242, 99243, 99244, 99245, and HCPCS D9310) provided via telemedicine may be covered only when used as a second opinion.

Office consultations provided via telemedicine may be reimbursed only if the consulting provider is of a different specialty than the requesting provider.

Office consultations performed by a provider of the same specialty within the same organization as the requesting provider are not covered.

## New Physical and Occupational Therapy Codes

Effective immediately for claims with dates of service on and after January 1, 2017, providers are required to use the new, more specific CPT codes for physical and occupational therapy evaluations:

- 97161 - Physical Therapy evaluation low complexity
- 97162 - Physical Therapy evaluation moderate complexity
- 97163 - Physical Therapy evaluation high complexity
- 97164 - Physical Therapy re-evaluation
- 97165 - Occupational Therapy evaluation low complexity
- 97166 - Occupational Therapy evaluation moderate complexity
- 97167 - Occupational Therapy evaluation high complexity
- 97168 - Occupational Therapy re-evaluation

Continue to use CPT codes 97001 – 97004 for dates of service prior to January 1, 2017.

## Federal Covered Outpatient Drug Rule Policy Clarification

Alaska Medicaid has issued a clarification and guidance letter regarding federal covered outpatient drug rule, CMS-2345-FC, effective April 1, 2017. The guidance letter, *CMS-2345-FC Final Rule Effective April 1, 2017*, is available at <http://manuals.medicaidalaska.com/docs/updates.htm>.



## Pharmacy Opioid Management Strategies and Initiative

Effective April 20, 2017, all pharmacy claims submitted for opioid prescriptions must include an ICD-10 diagnosis code. Also, pharmacy claims for buprenorphine-based products used for Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) of opioid dependence will not require service authorization for the first 28-day fill. Preferred Drug List rules will still apply.

## Ask Medicaid

**Q:** I work in a rural physician's office and I am arranging for a patient to travel to another community to receive medical services. The patient's travel has already been approved, and now I am filling out the travel forms. Do I need to complete the entire form, or do I leave some fields blank?

**A:** If you are the provider arranging transportation and accommodation services for your patient, you will only fill in certain parts of the Transportation Authorization and Invoice (AK-04) form and you will leave other fields blank for the transportation or accommodation provider to complete. Follow these steps to complete the necessary fields and leave the rest blank:

1. Begin by filling in **Service Authorization Number**, *field 8*, and **Authorized By**, *field 10*, with information provided by the Conduent Service Authorization Unit or appropriate tribal organization.
2. Complete the remaining fields *1 through 16*.
3. Enter the number of units approved for each service in *fields 19 and/or 24* (if units for escort are approved) but leave the charges fields blank.

Do **not** fill out any fields below the Patient and Escort sections or sign the bottom portion. Fields 26 and below are only for the transportation or accommodation provider rendering services. If the arranging provider signs the AK-04, then the form will be invalidated and the member cannot use it to obtain services.

## Notice of Proposed Regulation Changes

The Department of Health and Social Services proposes to adopt regulation changes in Title 7 of the Alaska Administrative Code, dealing with Medicaid home and community-based waiver services, person-centered practices and settings requirements.
