



COVID-19 Vaccine Distribution Survey Overview

The State of Alaska is preparing for COVID-19 vaccine distribution. According to Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) planning documents, possible recipients of the initial allotment of vaccine (Phase 1) may include residents and employees of long-term care facilities or residential congregate settings, the elderly, those with certain underlying medical conditions, health care workers, and others determined to be essential workforce.

The CDC has indicated the first allotment of vaccine will be limited. As the state develops distribution plans for an initial constrained inventory of vaccine, it is important to understand the needs of Alaska's critical workforce and most at-risk populations, and the agencies providing services to these populations.
