

Coverage for Dental Fluoride Varnish Provided by Physicians, Nurse Practitioners, and Physician Assistants

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Alaska Medical Assistance allows reimbursement for dental fluoride varnish applications and oral evaluations performed by physicians, nurse practitioners and physician assistants who have successfully completed Oral Health or Caries Risk Assessment training.

Credentials

Each medical provider is responsible for successfully completing Oral Health or Caries Risk Assessment training that includes oral evaluation and topical fluoride varnish applications. Accepted trainings include online and in-person training courses and workshops that provide a certificate of completion. A certificate of completion from the training program is required and must be presented to Alaska Medical Assistance upon request.

Limitations of Coverage

- Alaska Medical Assistance will cover a maximum of four topical fluoride varnish applications (D1206) per calendar year.
- Coverage of oral evaluations (D0145) is limited to two oral evaluations per calendar year and is limited to patients under three years of age.

Billing

Topical fluoride varnish and oral evaluations performed by physicians, nurse practitioners, and physician assistants must be billed on the CMS-1500 or 837P using the following dental procedure codes:

- D1206 - topical fluoride varnish; therapeutic application for moderate to high caries risk patients
- D0145 - oral evaluation for a patient under three years of age and counseling with primary caregiver
