



Alaska Medicaid Policy Update Intensity-Modulated Radiation Therapy Delivery

Effective October 1, 2017 and in accordance with 7 AAC 105.100, Alaska Medicaid will pay for medically necessary Intensity-Modulated Radiation Therapy (IMRT) delivery in accordance with the following coverage criteria:

IMRT Delivery - Office Setting (Physician, ANP, PA) and Freestanding Radiation Oncology Center

IMRT delivery will be covered only when billed with the following HCPC codes:

- G6015 – Intensity modulated treatment delivery, single or multiple fields/arcs, via narrow spatially and temporally modulated beams, binary, dynamic MLC, per treatment session
- G6016 – Compensator-based beam modulation treatment delivery of inverse planned treatment using 3 or more high resolution (milled or cast) compensator; convergent beam modulated fields, per treatment session

IMRT Delivery – Outpatient Hospital

IMRT delivery will be covered only when billed with the following CPT codes:

- 77385 – Intensity modulated radiation treatment delivery (IMRT), includes guidance and tracking, when performed; simple
- 77386 – Intensity modulated radiation treatment delivery (IMRT), includes guidance and tracking, when performed; complex
